New jobs and skills are required as a result of new regulatory requirements and green technologies.

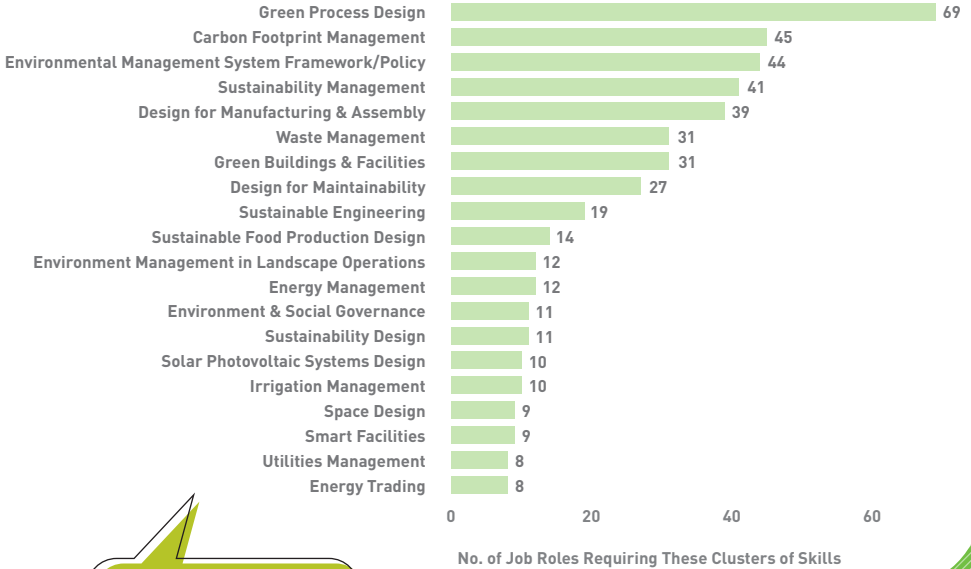
Existing jobs will encompass new skills to take on greener practices and work processes to support the Singapore Green Plan 2030.

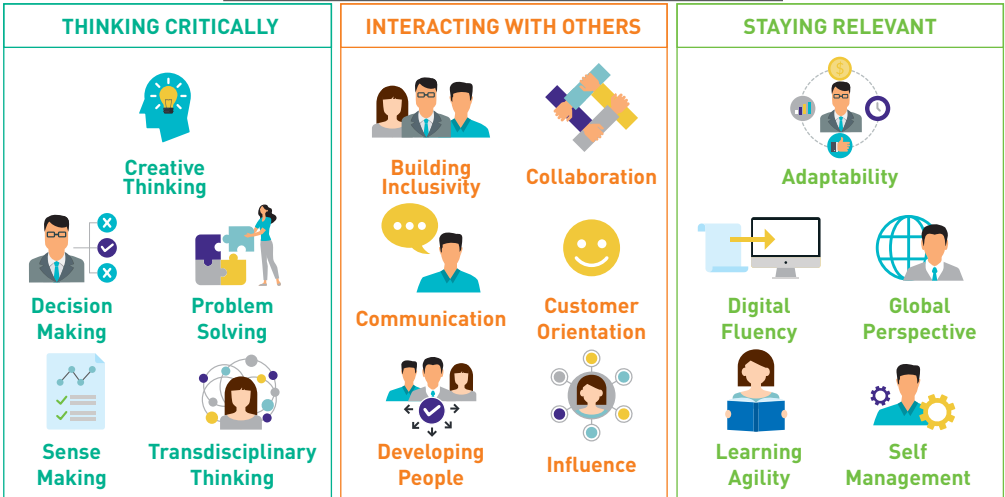
