He/She develops cargo mixture strategies, based on profit maximisation and customer demand, and manages all vessel operations planning to optimise capacity utilisation, terminal operations, vessel utilisation, vessel movement and route adjustment strategies.  He has a strong understanding of commercial and financial drivers in the shipping industry. He has strong leadership skills to manage multiple internal and external stakeholders and demonstrates commitment to exceptional customer service.
