Job Role	Senior Vessel Operator/Vessel Operator					
Job Role Description	The Senior Vessel Operator/Vessel Operator acts as the organisation's primary link with the ship's crew on matters relating to vessel movements and cargo operations. He/She liaises with the ship master to plan and execute the voyage and port/cargo operations. In addition, he liaises with regulatory bodies, terminal operators and port service providers, such as agents and bunker suppliers, maintains customer contact, and responds to problems that may arise from the voyage. He has good communication skills, can juggle the demands of multiple parties, and may be required to work irregular hours.
