<b>Job Role Description</b>	<p>The Psychologist provides psychological services within multi-disciplinary settings, applying a wide array of psychometric assessments and treatments for clients with routine psychological conditions. He/She conducts psychoeducational programmes and training for other professionals.</p> <p>He is a resourceful, proactive and collaborative professional, and works in varied settings such as public and private institutions, hospitals, healthcare and voluntary welfare organisations. He works under supervision and in collaboration with other professionals in the course of his work.</p>
