There are four emerging domains where green skills will be in demand:



Environmental and Sustainability Management

Skills relating to establishing governance and compliance to sustainability policies, systems and processes. These include Environment and Social Governance, and Sustainable Engineering.



Energy, Resource Circularity and Decarbonisation

Skills required for managing and maximising resources through measures to close the resource loop, use energy sustainably and mitigate global warming. In-demand skills include Renewable Energy System Management and Integration, and Urban Farming Business Development and Management.



Green Infrastructure and Mobility

Essential skills that support the transition towards a sustainable and eco friendly built environment, as well as the greening of air, land and sea transport systems for the urban infrastructure of our city state. For instance, Green Facilities Management Skills are in high demand.



Sustainable Finance

Skills to strengthen the financial ecosystem and provide sustainable finance, especially in regulations, standards setting, financial instruments for green investments, and the operationalisation of carbon markets. These include Carbon Footprint Management and Sustainable Investment Management.
