### FACTSHEET ON ADAPT & GROW VIRTUAL CAREER FAIR FOR NEW ENTRANTS FROM 31 OCTOBER TO 30 NOVEMBER 2018

Workforce Singapore (WSG) has rolled out an Adapt and Grow Virtual Career Fair (VCF) to curate career opportunities from the tourism and retail sectors for the new entrants. The VCF is part of the Government's efforts to enhance employment support for Singaporeans and to meet the needs of an increasingly educated workforce. It also serves to strengthen career matching between employers and fresh graduates.

2 Users will be able to have a virtual chat with hiring employers through the VCF, and get more insights on the various job positions, such as estimated salary, job requirements, possible progression pathways and expected working conditions. They will also be able to access a variety of career resources and tips to help them become more job-ready as they transit from school to the workforce.

3 The VCF will showcase more than 650 job vacancies from more than 30 employers, including Resorts World Sentosa, Singapore Airlines and Muji Singapore. Examples of job vacancies include management trainees, sales and marketing executives, operations executives, event management executives, etc. The VCF is expected to attract about 800 jobseekers.

4 The month-long VCF starts on 31 Oct 2018 and will end on 30 Nov 2018. Interested jobseekers may access the platform anytime, anywhere via [www.adaptandgrow.seemecv.com](http://www.adaptandgrow.seemecv.com).
