## Factsheet on SkillsFuture Career Advisors Programme

The SkillsFuture Career Advisors Programme is a new initiative under Adapt and Grow, in partnership with key intermediaries from the industry, such as Trade Associations and Chambers (TACs) and professional bodies.

- 2. Under the programme, Workforce Singapore will build a pool of SkillsFuture Career Advisors to provide industry career advisory and help job seekers expand their understanding of the skills and jobs in demand in specific sectors so as to be able to make informed career decisions about the sectors.
- 3. The SkillsFuture Career Advisors Programme has been rolled out first for the Infocomm Technology (ICT) sector, in a tripartite partnership with Infocomm Media Development Authority (IMDA), Workforce Singapore (WSG), SkillsFuture Singapore (SSG), National Trades Union Congress (NTUC), e2i (Employment and Employability Institute) and Singapore Computer Society (SCS). The sectoral initiative is called the SCS Career Compass. Under the SkillsFuture Career Advisors programme for the ICT sector, ICT career mentors will provide advice and share their experience with individuals interested in a career in the sector.
- 4. The programme will be rolled out progressively in other sectors. More details will be released in due course.
