MySkillsFuture (MySkillsFuture.sg) is a one-stop portal for all Singaporeans, aged 11 and above, to make informed learning and career choices, so that they can pursue skills and career development throughout their lives. The Portal will be a resource for students to learn more about different industry sectors and educational pathways through interactive tools; working adults to look for suitable training courses and job opportunities; employers to look for potential candidates for job vacancies; and training providers to promote their training programmes.

FEATURES AND HIGHLIGHTS

Career Quest (Pri)	<i>Career Quest</i> is a game that allows students to learn more about different industries, job roles and work values by using a customised avatar to explore a virtual world. By interacting with virtual characters and completing quests, students can discover the world of work in a fun and interactive way. Career Quest also features six mini games where students can find out more about their strengths and skills.
Know Yourself (Sec and Pre-U)	<i>Know Yourself</i> allows students to discover and identify their career interests, skills confidence, work values and learning styles. By helping to facilitate students' self-awareness, these tools provide a starting point for students to explore a variety of job roles and industries that are suited for them based on their areas of strength and interest.
World of Work	Students can explore the world of work through infographics, articles and videos, which include information on over 1000 job roles and over 30 associated industries.
Education Guide	Students can access information on the many education pathways, educational institutions and courses using the <i>Education Guide</i> . It has an interactive map of the Singapore education landscape and guiding questions to help students make informed decisions about their education plans. Students can also search for information on institutions and courses using various search criteria, as well as compare them against one another.

Industry Insights	<i>Industry Insights</i> is a resource for industry information, background and outlook, facts and figures, and occupational insights.
Training Exchange	<p><i>Training Exchange</i> is a one-stop platform for individuals to search and compare courses to suit their needs.
