Make The Change Integrated Programme Graduation Ceremony

The Make the Change Integration Programme is a 7-month pilot training programme that aims to expose trainees to the various forms of design and help them gain an understanding of fundamentals such as design principles, symbols and colours. At the same time, trainees learn how to use industry-standard applications from Adobe such as Photoshop, Illustrator, InDesign and Dreamweaver. In this way, trainees can create visual communication media such as posters, logos, corporate identities as well as websites and magazines. The pilot batch of 11 trainees from Muscular Dystrophy Association Singapore completed their training on 19 August 2016.
